We are always grateful for more prayer partners, but we need new monthly financial partners in order to continue in ministry.

2 - We have sent two additional applications to churches in Colorado. Please pray that these applications are received into the proper hands and that the Spirit of God would move his people to join our team. We would also like to visit these churches in person. Pray for God to work out the logistics of a visit in the coming weeks.

3 - On Tuesday this week (March 17), we will be meeting the missions pastor at the church we have been attending in the Dallas area. Pray for a sweet time of fellowship and an ability to communicate our passion for ministry and the tangible needs we are facing. We have been very blessed by this church already!

4 - Towards the end of this week we will meet with our Wycliffe supervisor. Pray for a good time discussing financial needs and ministry strategy. We are facing a deadline regarding our financial support. Pray that God would raise up the needed financial partners to meet the remaining 30%.
